Symphony Partners with Auburn Schools

Auburn, WA: Auburn Symphony Orchestra will perform Carnegie Hall's reputable Link Up program for Auburn fourth grade students on April 22, 2022 at the Auburn Performing Arts Center. Link Up is a program produced by orchestras worldwide in which students learn to sing and play an instrument in the classroom and culminates in a live, interactive concert with ASO where students sing, dance, and use body percussion with the symphony from their seats. The curriculum includes responses to current social justice movements and social emotional learning.

The Symphony has partnered with elementary school music teachers in Auburn School District and Muckleshoot Tribal Schools during the 2021-2022 academic year to provide this high quality music program that enhances what students are already learning in the classroom. 1,200 Auburn fourth grade students will participate in the program this year with a culminating event that is either virtual or in-person.

This program was made possible by a community-wide partnership. Supporters include the City of Auburn and Auburn Arts Commission, Timberland Bank, Auburn Public Schools Foundation, and Auburn Kiwanis Club.
